## **Day 1 – Trusting God with The Unknown**

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding." — Proverbs 3:5

Trust is not built in certainty; it is formed in the unknown. There are times when God asks us to take a step without showing us the full picture. Like Abraham who left everything familiar, or Peter who stepped out of the boat, God is calling you to trust Him beyond what you can see.

Today, choose to trust God not because you understand everything, but because you know He is good. Your faith will grow as you take one step at a time with Him.

### **Reflection Questions**

- What is one area in your life where you need to trust God more?
- What fears are you holding onto that God is asking you to release?

### Prayer

Lord, help me to trust You even when the path isn't clear. Give me courage to follow You into the unknown, knowing You are already there. Amen.

### Day 2 - Trusting God's Timing

"He has made everything beautiful in its time." — Ecclesiastes 3:11

Waiting can feel like a wilderness. But it's often in the waiting that God is doing His greatest work in us. When nothing seems to be happening on the surface, roots are growing deep. God's timing is perfect, and His delays are never denials. Trust that He is preparing both the blessing and your heart to receive it.

### **Reflection Questions**

- What promise are you waiting on God to fulfill?
- How can you embrace this season of waiting as part of God's plan?

#### **Prayer**

Lord, I surrender my timeline to You. Help me to rest in Your perfect timing, knowing You are never late. Amen.

### **Day 3 – Trusting God Through Loss**

"The Lord is close to the brokenhearted." — Psalm 34:18

Loss is part of life, but so is God's comfort. He meets us in our pain, not with quick fixes, but with presence. When we face grief, whether the loss of a loved one, a dream, or a season, He gently reminds us that He is still with us.

Let your tears fall in His hands. He is not afraid of your pain. He draws near to heal and to carry what feels too heavy for you.

### **Reflection Questions**

- Where in your life are you grieving right now?
- How can you invite God into that space today?

### **Prayer**

Lord, I give You my sorrow. Hold me close, help me trust that You are healing what's broken in me. Amen.

## Day 4 – Trusting God When You Feel Insecure

"You are altogether beautiful, my darling; there is no flaw in you." — Song of Songs 4:7

Insecurity whispers lies that you're not enough. But God speaks truth over you, you are chosen, loved, and perfectly crafted. The world may overlook you, but the One who formed you never will. He doesn't call the qualified; He qualifies the called. Your worth isn't in what you do, but in who He says you are.

### **Reflection Questions**

- What lies have you believed about yourself?
- What truth from God's Word will you declare today instead?

### **Prayer**

Lord, remind me who I am in You. Silence the voice of insecurity and help me live in the confidence of Your love. Amen.

### Day 5 - Trusting God with Your Future

"For I know the plans I have for you..." — Jeremiah 29:11

We often want control because we fear the unknown. But your future is not a mystery to God. He has plans—good ones. Even when your path seems winding or delayed, God is weaving something beautiful. You don't need to know the future to trust the One who holds it.

### **Reflection Questions**

- What part of your future are you worried about?
- How can you release that to God today?

#### **Prayer**

Lord, I give You my future. Write my story in Your timing and for Your glory. Amen.

# **Day 6 – Trusting God in Weakness**

"My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." — 2 Corinthians 12:9

### **Reflection Questions**

- Where do you feel most inadequate right now?
- How can you let God's strength carry you in that area?

Lord, I confess my weakness. Let Your grace flood in and be enough for today. Amen.
